We are currently accepting applications for a permanent full-time Reel Technician to join our Shimano Australia Fishing division in Caringbah (Sutherland Shire).

The primary duties will include but are not limited to;

- Servicing and repairing of fishing reels to the highest possible standard
- Identifying fishing reel faults, failures and assist other team members to repair reels
- Contribute to and liaise with spare parts team
- To work together as a team to meet minimum turnaround times for reel repairs
- Ensure data integrity to assist in stock level management for spare parts.
- Assist with the picking and/or packing of orders
- Assist in rolling stock takes of parts.
- To assist sales in prepping (pre servicing and spooling up) reels for sponsored anglers and charter boats.
- To provide customers with required information about upgrading parts to their reels when requested.

To be successful in this role you will need to have:

- Good written and verbal communication skills with a customer centric attitude
- Be computer literate
- Mechanically minded, ability to diagnose, read schematics, undertake mechanical repairs, action mechanical faults and problem solve independently
- Confident to handle and operate electrical hand tools
- Demonstrate high attention to detail and take pride in work
- Keen, reliable and enthusiastic to learn, a true team player
- Have full Australian Working rights
- Familiarity of Shimano products
- Prior experience in servicing of fishing reels or working in a similar workshop is highly regarded

This position would suit an individual who is mechanically minded and familiar with Shimano fishing products / equipment. The successful candidate will be working onsite in Caringbah and be required to a work rotating shift pattern from 7am to 3pm, and then from 9am to 5pm. In return Shimano Australia Fishing will provide ongoing training, onsite free parking, access to EAP programs, and regular social activities /community events.

Applications are to include a covering letter outlining your suitability to this role, noting your salary expectations, and attaching your updated resume.
